### Who are we?

Arohanui Specialist Teacher Outreach Service is a joint initiative between the Ministry of Education and Arohanui Special School. The service aims to support students with ORS funding in their local schools while providing specialised education services and programmes by trained teachers.

#### How does it work?

The local school transfers the ORS component, .1 or .2 to Arohanui School.

Arohanui will provide a .1 or .2 Specialist Itinerating Teacher who will visit the student and work with staff and families.

MOE provide additional funding to Arohanui for transport and resourcing costs.

The Outreach Service does not impact on teacher aide hours, SEG funding or allocation of specialist support through MOE SE.
